

**Call for a Research Fellowship, within the scope of the
Project “Era uma vez um peixe chamado bacalhau...
Para uma utilização sustentável dos recursos marinhos”**

Call for a Research Fellowship (BI) for a Bachelor’s Degree holder, within the scope of the Project “Era uma vez um peixe chamado bacalhau... Para uma utilização sustentável dos recursos marinhos”, with the reference PT-INNOVATION-0036, funded by EEAGrants 2014-2021 – Programa Crescimento Azul (SGS #3) – Apoio às iniciativas para a educação – Literacia do Oceano, under the following conditions:

1. Scientific Area: Education

2. Admission Requirements: Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree and be registered in a Master's degree.

Preferably, they should have experience in the development of didactic content and strategies, in particular through technologies, aimed at school-age children and young people, and experience in research in the field of Social Sciences.

3. Work Plan: The fellowship holder will carry out the following activities:

- Collecting statements, life stories, testimonies, documents, from people connected to cod fishing (videos, photographs);
- Collaborating in the creation of a digital resource, based on the collected elements (image and video edition, production of hypertexts);
- Creating a guide for the didactic exploration of the digital contents collected;
- Building data collection instruments to test the didactic exploration guide in a school context (interviews, questionnaires);
- Field monitoring the use of the resource created by several schools;
- Qualitatively and quantitatively analyzing the collected data during testing;
- Supporting the organization of reports, meetings and seminars.

4. Applicable Legislation and Regulations: Research Fellowship Statute, approved by Law No. 40/2004, of August 18, in its current wording; Regulation of Research Grants of the Universidade de Lisboa, published in annex to Order No. 6238/2020, DR 2nd Series, No. 113, of 12 June 2020; FCT Regulation for Research Studentships and Fellowships, in effect.

5. Workplace: The work will be carried out at the Instituto de Educação da Universidade de Lisboa under the scientific guidance of Cláudia Barreiros Macedo de Faria.

6. **Duration and regime of the fellowship:** The fellowship will last for 6 (six) months, starting in September 2021. The fellowship may be renewed as appropriate, within the duration of the project.

The performance of functions as a fellowship holder is carried out on a basis of exclusive commitment.

7. **Value of the Monthly Maintenance Allowance:** The fellowship holder is awarded a Monthly Maintenance Subsidy (MMS) in the amount of €835.98 (eight hundred and thirty-five euros and ninety-eight cents) according to the table of values of the fellowship awarded by FCT, IP in the country (<https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>).

The fellowship holder will benefit from a personal accident insurance and, if not covered by any social protection scheme, may ensure the exercise of the right to social security by joining the voluntary social insurance scheme, pursuant to paragraph 1 of Article 22 of the Regulation of Research Grants of the Universidade de Lisboa.

8. **Fellowship Component Payments:** Payments due to the fellowship holder are made by bank transfer to the account identified by the fellowship holder or by check.

9. **Selection methods and respective valuation:** The selection process will be developed based on curriculum evaluation, letter of interest, professional experience and, if necessary, a selection interview. In evaluating the applications, the following criteria will be taken into account:

- a) Curriculum vitae (20%);
- b) Letter of Interest(40%);
- c) Professional experience in view of the expected work plan. Previous experience in creating didactic content and developing strategies for science education, in particular using technology. Experience in research in the field of Social Sciences (40%).

If necessary, only the 3 highest-scoring candidates in the document evaluation will be called to carry out the selection interview.

The classification of the interview will comply with the following criteria:

- a) Ability to work autonomously and creatively (40%);
 - b) Mastery of the procedures involved in the creation of teaching resources (30%);
 - c) Demonstrated motivation for performing the tasks (30%).
10. **Composition of the Selection Jury:** The jury was appointed by Order No. 28 of the Director of the Instituto de Educação da Universidade de Lisboa, of 1st July 2021, and is constituted by:
- Doutora Cláudia Barreiros Macedo de Faria, Assistant Professor of IE-ULisboa, President,
 - Doutora Cecília Galvão Couto, Full Professor of IE-ULisboa, Member,

- Doutora Maria João Mogarro, Associate Professor of IE-ULisboa, Member,
- Doutora Maria Isabel Seixas da Cunha Chagas, Assistant Professor of IE-ULisboa, substitute Member.

11. **Form of publicity/notification of results:** The final evaluation results will be publicized, through a list sorted *by the final grade obtained*, posted in a visible and public place of the Instituto de Educação da Universidade de Lisboa and published on the website www.ie.ulisboa.pt, and the successful candidate will be notified by email.
12. **Application deadline:** The application is open from **July 15th** to **July 28th**, 2021.
13. **Form of submission of applications:** Applications must be formalized through the following documents:
 - a) Application Form, available at www.ie.ulisboa.pt;
 - b) Copy of the identification document (declaration of consent available at www.ie.ulisboa.pt);
 - c) Letter of Interest;
 - d) Detailed Curriculum Vitae;
 - e) Certificate of Qualifications 1, 2
 - f) Proof of registration in a study cycle leading to the academic degree;
 - g) Other documents that the candidates consider relevant.

NOTE 1: Documents proving the ownership of academic degrees or diplomas, or registration in a study cycle leading to the academic degree, may be dispensed with during the application stage, being replaced by a declaration of honor by the candidate, and verification of this condition is mandatory during the grant contracting stage.

NOTE 2: Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries require recognition by a Portuguese Institution in accordance with Decree-Law no. 66/2018, of August 16 and Ordinance No. 33/2019, of January 25th. Presentation of the recognition is mandatory for the signing of the contract. For more information see: <https://www.dges.gov.pt/pt/pagina/recognition?plid=374>. Under normal conditions, the non-delivery of recognition of the degree, within three months from the date of communication of approval in the context of scientific evaluation, implies the fellowship will not be granted.

- 14. Deadlines and procedures for complaints and appeals:** If the decision to be made is unfavorable to the granting of the requested fellowship, the candidates have a period of 10 working days, after the date of publication of the evaluation results, to comment, if they so wish, in a prior hearing, under the terms provided for in the Code of Administrative Procedure.

A complaint can be filed against the final decision to the Director of the Instituto de Educação da Universidade de Lisboa, within 15 working days after the respective notification.
